- Interviewer: **Where** do you study?

- Interviewee: I **seldom** go to college because I study marketing online

- Interviewer: **When** is your birthday?

- Interviewee: It's on November 14th but I **often** celebrate with my Friends

- Interviewer: Oh! That's right! Thanks for your attention.



# Frequency Adverbs



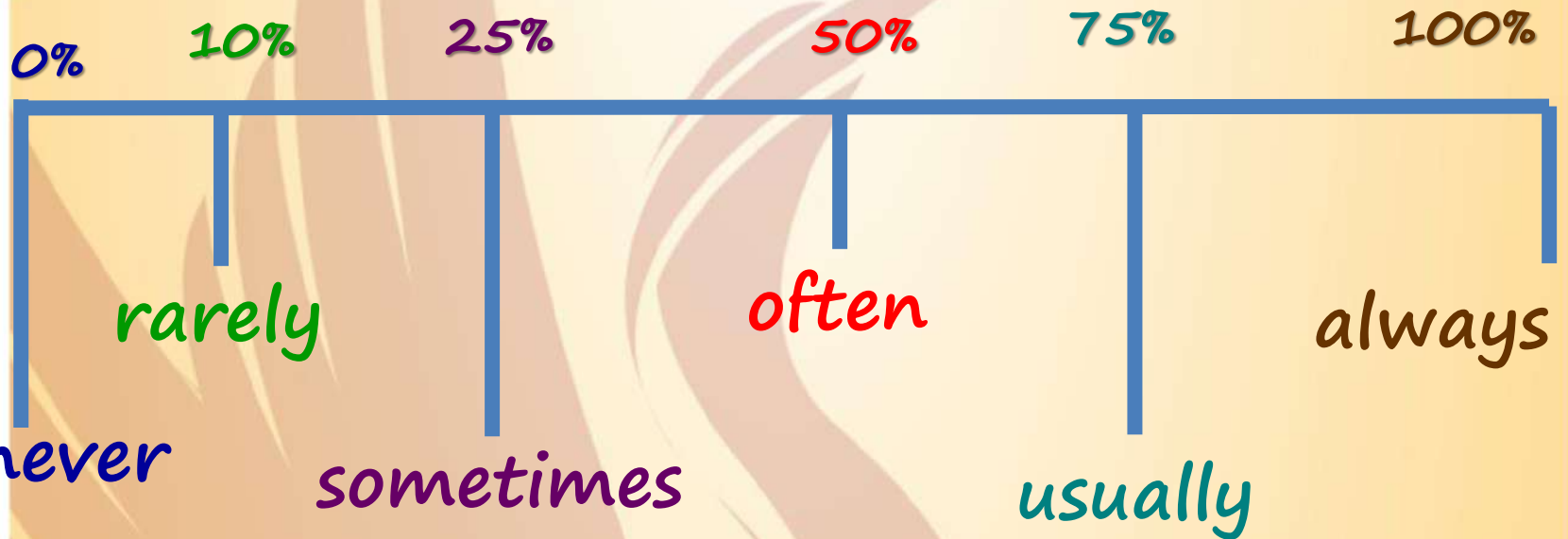
%	Adverb of Frequency	Example
100%	<b>Always</b>	I always study after class
90%	<b>Usually</b>	I usually walk to work
80%	<b>Normally / Generally</b>	I normally get good marks
70%	<b>Often / Frequently</b>	I often read in bed at night
50%	<b>Sometimes</b>	I sometimes sing in the shower
30%	<b>Occasionally</b>	I occasionally go to bed late
10%	<b>Seldom</b>	I seldom put salt on my food
5%	<b>Hardly ever / Rarely</b>	I hardly ever get angry
0%	<b>Never</b>	Vegetarians never eat meat

**Subject + Adverb + Main Verb**  
Daniel always passes his exams.

**Subject + BE + Adverb**  
He is always happy.

# Examples

- I never get up early on sundays.
- He rarely goes to the zoo.
- She sometimes has a sandwich for lunch.
- Do you often walk to work?
- Mum is usually home by four.
- He is always late for work

We often travel to Scotland





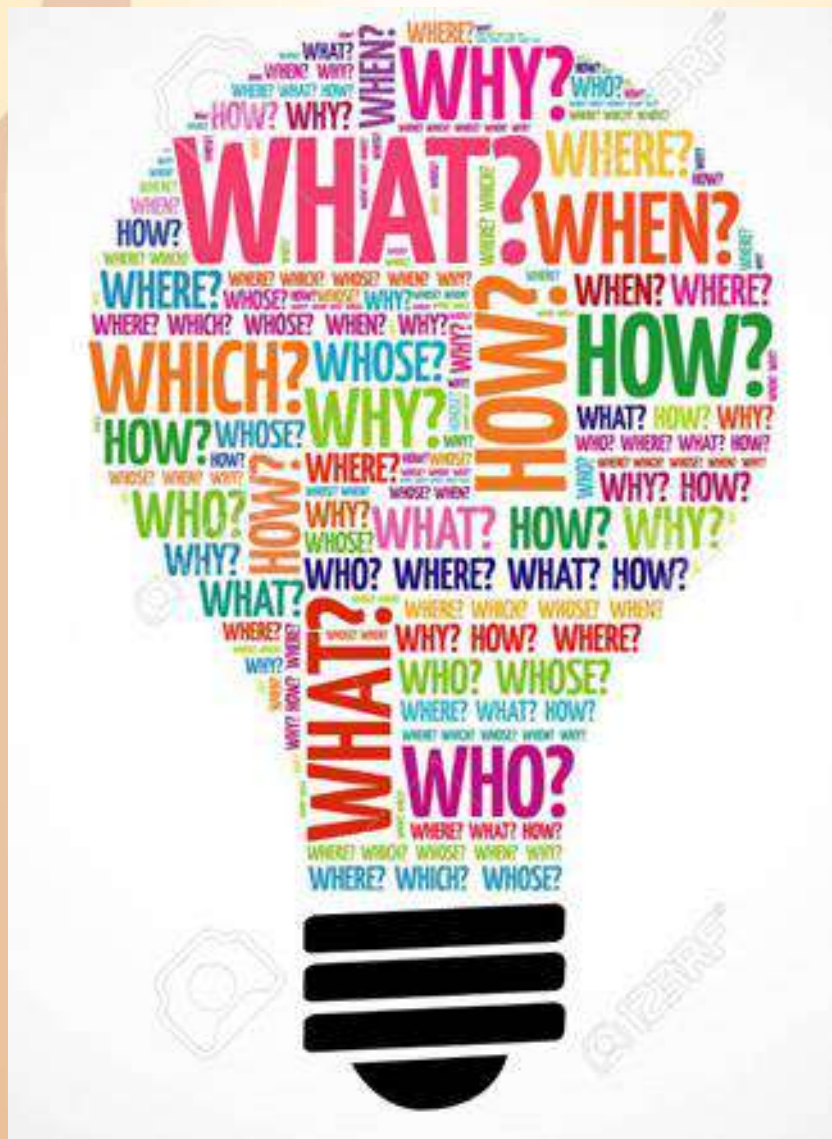
## Exercise 5

## What ?

It's used to ask about specific thing, people, animal, object.



## Which ?

It's used to ask about choice, alternative.



## Where ?

It's used to ask about place, position.



## Who ?

It's used to ask about people, person.



## When ?

It's used to ask about time, occasion, moment.



## Whose ?

It's used to ask about who the possessor of something.

## Why ?

It's used to ask about reason, explanation.



## How ?

It's used to ask about condition, quality, may, manner, form events and the way things.



***Where did you go swimming? In the swimming pool in town.***

***Why did you go there? Because it's a nice, big pool.***

***Who did you go swimming with? With Amy.***

***What time did you meet Amy? At 10 o'clock.***

***Which pool did you go in? The serious one, without the slides!***

***How did you get there? On the bus.***

  - Where do you live?
  - Where does she come from?
  - Why do you study?
