Rosie: 'I'<u>m studying music in the afternoons</u>'
Matt: 'I <u>can't believe you are here in the party, it has been ages</u>'
Wendy: 'I'<u>m getting married next year</u>'



RESARROLLO DEL TEMA



Today you meet your friends at school, you tell them about the party. You tell them what your friends said:

Patty said that she <u>played golf regularly</u>
Rosie said that she <u>was studying music</u> in the afternoons.

•Matt told me he <u>couldn't believe</u> I <u>was</u> there in the party, it <u>had been</u> ages

•Wendy said that she <u>was getting</u> married next year.



DESARROLLO DEL TEMA



When you are saying to somebody what someone said before, you are using **REPORTED SPEECH...**

- When we use *reported speech*, the main verb of the sentence is usually *past*. We use a reporting verb, usually say or tell followed by *that*:
 - Patty said that...
- The rest of the sentence is usually *past* too:
 - ... she **played** golf regularly.



DESARROLLO DEL TEMA Say or Tell?



• Say: No indirect object.

- Diana: 'I'm tired' / Diana said that she was tired.

• Tell: an indirect object.

- Diana: 'I'm tired, Ted' / Diana told Ted that she was tired.

• But say something to somebody

- Diana: 'I'm tired' / Diana said to me that she was tired.
