FUTURE

1. - **WILL** → PREDICTIONS

People will have robots in their homes.

People won't have robots in their homes.

Will people have robots in their homes?

2.- **WILL BE ABLE TO** → FUTURE OF CAN

You will be able to win the competition.

You won't be able to win the competition.

Will you be able to win the competition?





3.- **MIGHT** → POSSIBILITY

Luis might (not) get married.

4.- **GOING TO** → FUTURE PLANS AND AMBITIONS

I am (not) going to study a master degree. /

Am I going to study a master degree?

She is (not) going to work in a café. / Is she going to work in a café?

We are (not) going to play tennis next week. /

Are we going to play tennis next week?





5.- **PRESENT CONTINUOUS**  **FUTURE**
ARRANGEMENTS

The arrangement doesn't have to be in the near future.
The important thing is how certain we are about it.





Examples:

She is (not) having a party tomorrow night. /
Is she having a party tomorrow night?

I am (not) buying a new car on Saturday. /
Am I buying a car next Saturday?

We are (not) getting married in July next year. /
Are we getting married in July next year?
