We use the present perfect simple tense for:

- \*Actions that started in the past and continue in the present
- \*Recent events when the result is still visible
- \*With today, this month,... when that period hasn't finished yet.
















# Present perfect structure

Form	I, You, We, They	He, She, It
Affirmative	I <b>have tidied</b> my bedroom.	He <b>has tidied</b> his bedroom.
Negative	I <b>have not tidied</b> my bedroom. I <b>haven't tidied</b> my bedroom.	He <b>has not tidied</b> his bedroom. / He <b>hasn't tidied</b> his bedroom.
	<b>Have you tidied</b> my bedroom?	<b>Has he tidied</b> his bedroom?





<p><b>Affirmative</b></p>	  Have / Has  Main verb in past participle  Complement
<p><b>Negative</b></p>	  Have / Has  <b>NOT</b>  Main verb in past participle <b>Haven't / Hasn't</b>
<p><b>Interrogative</b></p>	Has Have    Main verb in past participle  

# Related words

## FOR or SINCE

**Since: The beginning of a period.**

**Example:** I haven't visited my grand parents since January.

**For: A whole period.**

**Example:** I haven't watched T.V. for a long time,
