# Presente Perfecto

*Área Académica: Ingeniería Industrial*

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The present perfect simple expresses an action that is still going on or that stopped recently, but has an influence on the present. We use the Present Perfect to say that an action happened at an unspecified time.

## **RESUMEN:**

# KEY WORDS:

**Have, has, ever, since, yet, never, already, just, for.**



**USE 1** Unspecified time before now

Example:

People have participated in the new elections

USES

FOMS

Present  
Perfect

**USE 2** Duration from the Past until now

Example:

She has been in England for six months

**AFFIRMATIVE FORM**  
I, We, You, They + have + Past participle  
He, she, It + has + Past participle

**USE 3** Experience

Example:

I have eaten snails in London

**NEGATIVE FORM**  
I, We, You, They + haven't + Past participle  
He, she, It + hasn't + Past participle

**USE 4** Accomplishments

Example:

Scientists have split the atom

**INTERROGATIVE FORM**

Have + we, you, they + Past participle...?  
Has + he, she, it + Past participle...?
