But, what do they do in their job?



- A **civil engineer** is the person who **supervises** the construction of roads, highways, skyscrapers, buildings and more.
- A **bricklayer** is the person who **helps** engineers to build houses, roads or any other kind of building.



- A **journalist** is the person who **makes** interviews, **looks for** information in real context, **reports** news in a TV or radio program.



- A **cleaner** is the person who **helps** with the cleanning, the washing up and the laundry in houses, hotels, buildings and/or schools.

- A **doctor** is the person who **checks** and **supervises** people's health in a hospital or clinic.



Note:

- Remember, when we speak in Simple Present and about one 3rd. Person, our verb needs to be modified like in the examples below:
 - **Fix – fixes**
 - **Come – comes**
 - **Walk – walks**
 - **Catch - catches**
