## Desarrollo del Tema:

How much ?      How many?



**When we want to know the quantity or amount of something we ask questions starting with:**

**How much...? / How many... ?**



A **countable noun** is anything that can **be counted** in separate units:

buildings, cars, dots, bottles, pencils, children, etc.

You want to know the quantity or amount



**How many + plural (contable) noun.**

With them we use **how many**:

**How many** cars are in your garage? There are ten cars.



An **uncountable nouns** are those that **we can't count** in individual units:  
water, air, light, snow, rain, iron, etc.



With them we use **how much**:



**How much** water is in that glass? There is **a little**.

**How much + uncountable noun.**

# You want to know the Price (\$)



**How much** is this dress?

It costs \$300 pesos.



**How much** are these shoes?

There are \$ 800 pesos

**How much + singular / plural noun (or with the verb “cost” or “be”)**



## Remember ...

- For countable things,  
use **many**.
- For uncountable things,  
use **much**.
