# TEMA: COMPARANDO PERSONAS, LUGARES Y COSAS

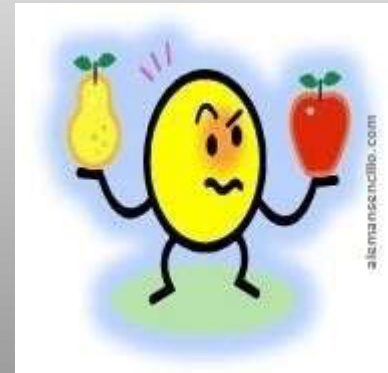
Comparative is the name for the grammar used when comparing two things.

We use **comparative adjectives** to describe people and things

We use **than** when we want to compare one thing with **another**.

I'm feeling **happier** now ----- (describing people )

She is two years older **than** me --- (comparing two things )



# TEMA: COMPARANDO PERSONAS, LUGARES Y COSAS.

When comparing with **than**, some changes are necessary, depending on the number of syllables the adjective has

- When syllable adjectives: we add **-er** to the adjective.



Ex. My brother is old + er (**older**) than me

- When syllable adjectives ending in **-y**: we change the **-y** to **-ier**.

Ex. The biology class is easy + er (**easier**) than English class.

- When adjectives with 3 or more syllables: we use **more** + the unchanged adjective.

Ex. My sister is **more** + **intelligent** than me

# TEMA: COMPARING PEOPLE

I like playing basketball with my brother, but sometimes I do not like it because he is taller than me and he always is the winner. My brother is older than me, but I am more intelligent than him, and that makes me a better person. I love my parents but specially I love my mom because she is calmer than my dad, and also because she is a better person, my dad is angrier than my mom but I love both of them for being my parents.
